Each student's personal musical interests are considered in their individual program. So, whether you are preparing for a Royal Conservatory exam or getting ready for your first gig, the teachers of KAOS Music can help you get there.

**What types of private lessons does KAOS Music offer?** - We offer private lessons in piano,



guitar, bass, drums, voice and woodwind instruments. All of our private lessons are 30 minutes in length, scheduled once per week. Students can begin any time by calling or dropping in to arrange a convenient lesson time. Once setup, we take care of the details while you concentrate on learning and having fun. Our private lessons are intended for students ages 7 to adults.

**What types of group lessons does KAOS Music offer?** - For children ages 3-7 we offer group lessons using the famous Yamaha Music Education System. These group classes begin in September and run until the end of June. See separate brochure for detailed information.

### Do you need an instrument for lessons? -

A common challenge for parents is the question of whether or not to purchase an instrument for a child before they begin lessons. As we all know, it is not unheard of for a child to change their mind about what they enjoy. Owning an instrument that is not being used is not only frustrating, its expensive.

Thankfully, given that we are also a music store, we offer a FREE one time rental program to all of our new students. This program is called

### The Getting Starting in Music Program.

How it works is very simple. To qualify for this program you simply need to be a new student and register for 20 weeks of lessons. In return we provide you with a new instrument to use for your first 20 weeks at no charge. The only thing you that you pay for are the lessons.

At the end of the 20 weeks, you have 2 choices, return the instrument with no rental fee or purchase it at our normal competitive selling price.

The only time we charge a rental fee is if you drop out of lessons before the end of the initial 20 week period. So, go ahead get started... KAOS Music makes it easy

**How do I register for lessons?** - Registering for lessons at KAOS Music is very easy. It involves two basic steps.

First, you either call, email or visit our store to find a suitable time slot in our schedule. Second you register and pay for your lessons.

Once registered, we automatically take care of future registrations until the end of our school year (end of June) using either your credit card or your provided post dated cheques.

**What if I want to stop lessons?** - Even though we register our lessons in 10 week pay periods, students are free to begin and discontinue lessons at any time.

If you decide to stop lessons, simply notify us and we will promptly refund any future prepaid lessons to you with absolutely no penalty charges, just our thanks for taking lessons with us.

### How does the automatic payment

**process work?** - We charge for our lessons in 10 week periods. So, every 10 weeks we automatically charge your credit card for the next 10 weeks of lessons.

This automatic process is employed for your convenience. If you prefer, you may use post dated cheques. As we take care of the financial details, including credits for missed lessons, this process ensures that nobody forgets to register which could result in a lost time slot.
